

GRAND NATIONAL LEGACY FUND

The Grand National Quilt Show was inaugurated in 2003 to encourage and showcase the work of quilters and fibre artists, both traditional and innovative, across Canada. Though **Oh! Canada 2017** will be its last, the volunteer committee at its heart is determined that this fine tradition should continue. The Committee has established **The Grand National Legacy Fund** within the Kitchener Waterloo Community Foundation that will, beginning in 2018, award annually a grant of \$1000 to an organization that presents a public exhibition or event that highlights the textile arts in Canada.

Donations to the Grand National Legacy Fund can be made directly through the KW Community Foundation. Tax receipts are available for \$20 donations and over.
